## Serve

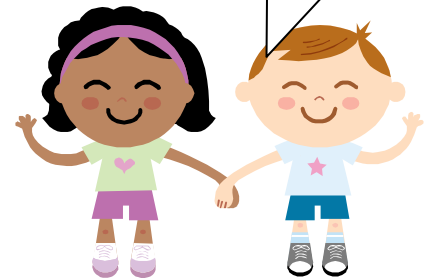
