Communicate



We constantly communicate with other people and we say so much without opening our mouths! We communicate with our facial expressions, our body language, our eyes; we use our hands to type words and some people use their hands to sign. As well as this we communicate so much in the way we speak and act towards others like story of the Good Samaritan.

In recalling the story we can think how the people within it treated a stranger:

The Robbers	Priest and Levite	The Samaritan
Rob him	Harm him by inaction	Pays for him
Leave him dying	Leave him unhelped	Leaves him cared for
Abandon him	Neglected him	Promises to return

The robbers hurt the man by violence, the Priest and Levite, by neglect. All three are guilty. "To the one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin," ([James 4:17](#)).

In this story Jesus was making us think about how treat our neighbour, we think about this as we meet new people today. May our words, gestures and actions be positive as we follow the message communicated through Saint Bernadette from Mary Our Mother.
